

ECE 290C : Early Childhood Leadership Seminar

Explores the role of the early childhood professional in the workplace. Topics discussed include leadership, working in a team, and professional ethics. Students develop a resume and create a professional portfolio for interview purposes. Emphasis is placed on the role of ongoing professional development activities and involvement in the early childhood field through participation in boards and meetings around topics specific to the field.
